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NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF FINAL PROGRAMMATIC ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT (FINAL PEIR)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of San Mateo Clean Water Program Final Programmatic Environmental Impact Report (Final PEIR) has been completed and is available for public and agency review.

PROJECT LOCATION: The program area for the Clean Water Program (CWP) is the area where CWP projects would be constructed and operated, generally within the City of San Mateo (City). Collection system projects would be located throughout the City of San Mateo, primarily in the eastern half. Wastewater treatment projects would be located at or adjacent to the existing wastewater treatment plant, at 2050 Detroit Drive near J. Hart Clinton Drive at the eastern edge of the City.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: The CWP is a series of projects to upgrade and increase the capacity of the City's wastewater treatment plant and sewer collection system to help eliminate sanitary sewer overflows and meet current and future regulatory requirements. Two alternatives that meet the CWP objectives were evaluated at an equal level of detail:

1. In-System Storage Program
2. Full Conveyance Program.

The In-System Storage Program would include construction of one or more underground storage basins upstream from the Dale Avenue Pump Station to detain wastewater flows during peak wet weather events. The Full Conveyance Program would include a new pump station in the vicinity of the existing Dale Avenue Pump Station to convey peak flow to the wastewater treatment plant. The New Headworks and Primary Clarifier Replacement Projects are evaluated at a project-level of detail.

SIGNIFICANT ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECTS: The In-System Storage Program, the Full Conveyance Program, the New Headworks Project, and the Primary Clarifier Project would result in significant and unavoidable construction noise and vibration impacts, even with the proposed mitigation measures designed to reduce impacts. All other impacts would be less than

significant or would be reduced to a less than significant level with implementation of the proposed mitigation measures.

CONTENTS OF THE FINAL PEIR: The Final PEIR consists of the Draft PEIR and Draft PEIR Appendices in combination with the Response to Comments and Changes to the Draft PEIR. The Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) is included as a separate document.

CITY ACTIONS AFTER FINAL PEIR PUBLICATION: The Public Works Commission will receive public comment on and will make a recommendation to the San Mateo City Council regarding certification and adoption of the Final PEIR. The City Council will then make a decision on whether to certify and adopt the Final PEIR, approve a Preferred Alternative for the Clean Water Program, and adopt required findings, a statement of overriding considerations, and the MMRP, if applicable. The City will then file a Notice of Determination, and the 30-day statute of limitations will begin.
